Al-Anon Meetings

Caregiver Support Group meets each month on the **second Tuesday at 1:00 pm** in the church library. Join other Caregivers to gain information, share ideas, problem solve, and support each other. Facilitated by Brandi Schneider, LMSW. Questions? Call Peggy Way 479.253.1583 Masks are optional.

Our support group for Widow(er)s meets at the church library at **Noon** on the **first and third Wednesdays** of each month. Join us as we gather to share experiences and support each other on this journey. All are welcome. If you know a widow(er), let them know about our group.

A support group for people with Parkinson's and their Caregivers meets the **first Wednesday** of each month in the church library at **10 am**. This is open to anyone in the community!

We are so blessed to have faithful supporters and mentors that partner with us in our homeless/shower ministry. **Harold's Diner** has donated tokens that we can distribute to a homeless person which can be turned in for a free nutritious meal at the Diner. Some of you have expressed that you would love the opportunity to sit down in a safe environment with one of our clients, share a meal and conversation. If that sounds like you, call the church office and we can facilitate an opportunity for you to take a client to Harolds Diner for a meal and conversation, using the free token for the homeless meal. If you haven't been to Harold's Diner (17 White Street) you are in for a treat! Their menu is creative, healthy and delicious. Plus, they have a record collection which you can select from and play on their record player.

We will be working with some of our homeless clients on a fundraiser that will require clean wide mouth quart Mason jars with lids. If you have any to donate, please drop of at Narthex of church office. Thank you.

Welcome Home! Just last week three members of our unit attended Mission U: two in person at Hendrix College and another virtually. This annual event offers time in classes, creative workshops and group gatherings to explore meaningful issues and ideas. The "Welcome Home" study focused on the relationship that God desires to have with us individually and the relationship God hopes we will embrace with one another. Amazing! That's the same plan for ESUMC - love God and love one another...welcome home!

Our church showers are open to men and women so they can freshen up, do a load of laundry, and be ready for a job interview, medical appointment, or just a chance to be clean. Showers are available **Monday thru Thursday from 9 AM till 1:30 PM**.

Pantry Current needs: We are down to the bare bones in donations. We have had two large families come through on Wednesday which cleared out most of our stock. ANY donations would be much appreciated, including food staples, ingredients to make nutrient-dense meals; refried, pinto, kidney, garbanzo beans, peanut butter & crackers, sugar, flour, rice, pasta noddles, tomato sauce, granola-type bars (the soft kind because they often have dental issues), men & women sturdy sneakers/hiking boots. Women's good walking/hiking shoes, Size 10. Donations can be dropped off at the church. We are looking for volunteers to come in once a week to give the showers a good cleaning.

The Mobile Food Pantry serves Carroll County residents in need of food staples. Our **next pick-up date is Wednesday, August 14, 8:30 AM.** We deliver food items on a <u>very limited basis</u>, only to those with no transportation or someone to pick up for them. Deadline for delivery requests is <u>Noon on Tuesdays</u> so that the schedule can be finalized & disbursed to volunteer drivers. We are very appreciative of our loyal band of volunteers who make this happen rain, heat, sleet, and sunshine.
